
Adwika Chandra 5C also participated in Sansad Khel Spardha age group10 and secured First position.

The session focused mainly in training teachers to make effective lesson plans in physics, innovative ways of using the laboratory in teaching the subject, common errors made by teachers and difficulties faced by teachers in teaching abstract concepts of physics.
