

The Principal's Address






Also as the world becomes more and more globalized, advanced language skills help to demonstrate that you have a host of other capabilities as well.



 - **Nukaraju Paila** (Art/Craft Teacher) for creative art piece of Lord Buddha which was created by using cutlery sets.


