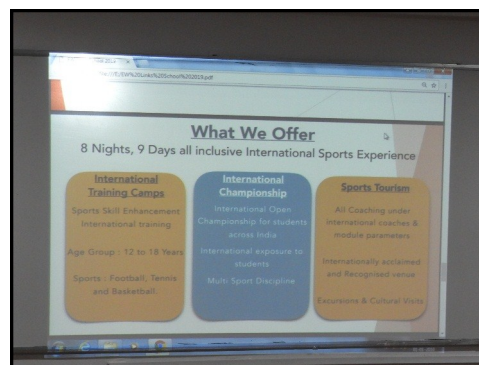
NIMUN 9
