EARTH DAY ACTIVITIES PRE-PRIMARY & PRIMARY

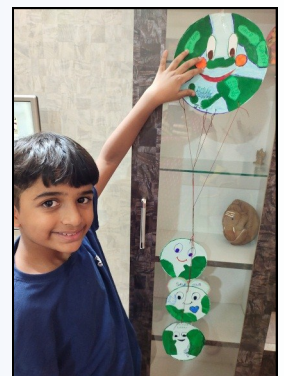

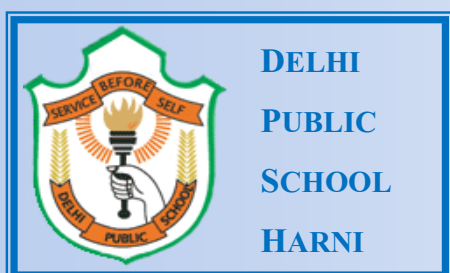
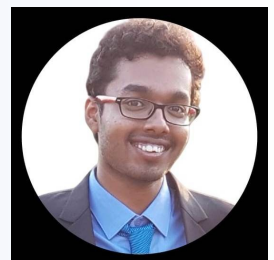
