c. The school is required to ensure that no staff member may be appointed / continued in the services of

the school who has attained the age of superannuation.

d. The School Managing Committee is required to be reconstituted having each of 02 parents representative, teacher representatives and 02 Principals of affiliated schools preferably of Kendriya Vidyalaya /Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya.

e. The school is required to create the reserve fund as per strength of the school in the joint names of Secretary, CBSE and Manager of the school as per provisions of Affiliation Bye-Laws

of the Board and copy of FDR so created be furnished to the Board for record purpose.

f. A documentary proof regarding implementation and regular deduction of EPF is required to be

submitted alongwith latest Pay Bill and Bank Challan.

g. As per details of enrollment of students of the school, optimum limit is not maintained in all classes. Hence section-wise enrollment of students may be restricted with optimum number of 40 students per section.

Provisions of Affiliation Bye-laws for adherence:-

- Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. No capitation fee or voluntary donations for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure i.a.w. rule no. 11.1, 2 & 3.
- 2. The school should not use the activities for commercialization:-

a) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) It shall ensure that the school is run as a community service and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any shape whatsoever.

- b) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii)a Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, motto and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school / society has not entered into any such contract to use name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.
- Teachers are to be made educated regarding corporal punishment & should avoid any type of such involvement i.a.w. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).
- School will not prepare any student/ start class for any other Board except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/ premises.
- Admission to the school is to be made restricted under rule 6.1 of Examination Bye-laws and rule 12 (i, ii & iii) of Affiliation Bye-laws.
- 6. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from sexual harassment at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaskha and other State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997 mentioned under rule no. 10.9.
- 7. Each school affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame Service Rules for its employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye-laws. Further, Service contract will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the State/U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the State Education Act.
- 8. Pay and allowances to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government. Further, Salary and service conditions of staff should be provided i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (v) and rule no. 10.2 as appended below:
 - a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-laws also be adhered to.

b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointment of the teachers on probation.

- 11. Running of classes of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- 12. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'Persons with Disabilities Act 1995'.

- 15. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school to develop their own website containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, address-postal and e-mail, telephone nos. etc.
- 16. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least one week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
- 17. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a **Health Wellness teacher** as per rule 53.5.
- 18. Strict adherence to the provisions of Wild Life Protection Act while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 00 dated 21 May 2013.
- 19. As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of private publishers. The content must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If found prescribed books having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.

Conditions for which Compliance to be submitted with in three months from the date of issue of sanction letter:-

- Running /Starting of class IX/X or XI/XII without prior Provisional Affiliation upto Secondary level /Sr. Secondary level from the Board would be unauthorised and school shall be responsible for the consequences arising out of it.
- Non submission of application for extension of Provisional Affiliation by 30th June of the year preceding to the year by which provisional affiliation granted, expires, would also attract violation of provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- School will not prepare any student/start any class for any other Board except CBSE from their CBSE Affiliated school Building/premises.
- 4. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one Society /Management / Trust to another Society / Management / Trust through agreement /sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effects.
- Pay and allowances to staff should be revised from time to time to bring it at par with that to the State Government.
- The service conditions be strictly followed as per State Education Act and staff be given appointment / Confirmation letters etc, accordingly.
- 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee. Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV
- 8. The School shall maintain Section teacher Ratio at least 1:1:5 at each level i.e. primary (I-V) Secondary (VI-X) and Sr. secondary (XI-XII)
- The school has to constitute a committee for protection of women from sexual harrassment at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No. 666-70 of 1992 Vishakha and others state of Rajasthan and others delivered on 13/08/1997.
- 10. Rs. 450d ___ on account of annual fee for. ____ years may please be remitted.
- 11. The school shall maintain Reserve Fund in the joint names of the Manager of the school concerned and the Secretary of the Board in the scheduled Bank to the extent indicated below:-
