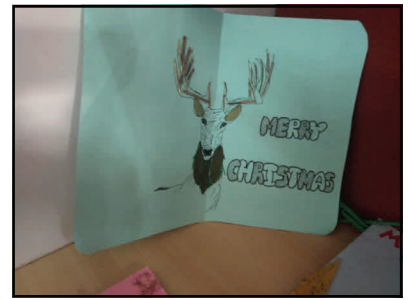
Girls team of DPS Harni under 14 category won the Final match against DPS Kalali held at Cygnus World School Football Tournament.

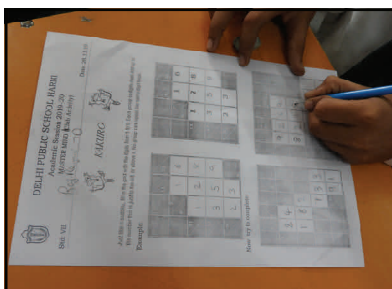
